Decision N° 1

The Stewards, having received a report (N°03) from the Technical Delegate, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the manufacturer named below and thus impose the penalty referred to.

Manufacturer: DUNLOP Racing

Date / Time 02-09-2017 9:45 a.m.

Facts Car 86 and 77 used unregistered tyres in FP1.

Offence Breach of Art. 7.7 of the Sporting Regulations

Penalty 5000€ Fine suspended pending compliance with Art. 7.7 during the 2017 season.

Reason The Manufacturer Dunlop along with the Competitor Representatives of car 86 and 77 were summoned and granted a hearing. The Manufacturer explained that during a change in the registration process a portion of their tyres failed to be included on the register list of tyres. The Stewards accepted that the Competitors were unable to check the registration of the tyres independently. Art. 7.7 now holds the Manufactures responsible for compliance with the regulations and while the Stewards accepted that the omission was a simple computer error they determined that a breach had occurred and therefor ordered a suspended fine to be imposed on the Manufacture, consistent with previous similar cases.

The Competitor/Manufacture is reminded of his right of Appeal under and in compliance with Art. 4.11.2 b of the WEC Sporting Regulations and Art.10 of the Judicial and Disciplinary Rules of the FIA.
