The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, heard the competitor and driver, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

No, Driver N°70 – Motoaki ISHIKAWA

Competitor MR RACING

Time Test Day Afternoon Session 15:35

Facts Contact with slow car signalled by white flags

Offence Breach of App. L, chap. 4, Art. 1 and 2.d

Decision Stop & Go suspended until the end of the 24 Hours of Le Mans Competition
The penalty will be applied in case of the same infringement.

Reason The competitor was informed by 2 white flags shown at the entry of T23 of a slow car on the track. Despite this information the driver didn't take in account the presence of the slow car in front of him and made a contact with it at T25. The stewards consider the lack of consideration of white flags as a dangerous driving.

According to Art. 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and the provisions of WEC Sporting Regulations this decision is not subject to appeal.
