Facts Causing a collision with car 4
Offence Breach of App. L, chap.4, 1b and Art. 2d of ISC
Decision 2 Minutes Stop & Go
Reason Car 37 moved from the centre of the track all the way to the left-hand side at the entry of T1 striking car 4 which was fully alongside. The stewards determined Car 37 was wholly at fault for the collision

According to Art. 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and the provisions of WEC Sporting Regulations this decision is not subject to appeal.
