The Stewards, having received a report from a judge of facts transmitted by the Race Director, summoned and heard the Team representative, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Competitor: 37 - JACKIE CHAN DC RACING
Time (fact): 21:30
Session: Race
Offence: 12.3.9 of 24 Hours Le Mans Supplementary Regulations
Decision: The Competitor is Disqualified

Reason: The car stopped on track, the driver exited the car and phone called his team. A member of the team met the driver and supplied a component which the driver fitted to the car. The car was then able to continue. During the hearing the team representative admitted to these facts. He also stated that the car would not have been able to continue without this fix. This is a breach of Art. 12.3.9 of 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations. The penalty in the Regulations is disqualification.

The Competitor is reminded of his right of Appeal under and in compliance with Art. 16.1.6 of 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations, Article 15 of the International Sporting Code, and Art. 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
