The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, summoned and heard the Team Representative, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor name below and decide as follows

N° / Driver: 92 / Kevin ESTRE
Competitor 92 - PORSCHE GT TEAM
Session: After FP1
Fact: Driver didn't cover the required night laps
Offence: 10.1.2 of WEC Sporting Regulations
Decision: No further action

Reason:

The Team Representative explained that due to an technical failure the car needed to stop for repairs. As the repairs took a longer time driver Kevin Estre couldn't get in the car to cover the required night laps. The Stewards accepted this explanation and allow the car to continue in the competition due to the fact that the driver has a lot of experience on the track and on driving at night.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.2.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Art. 16.2.7 of WEC Sporting Regulations this decision is not subject to appeal.
