



2021 SEASON TOP-4 STARTING DRIVERS BRIEFING NOTES

NOTES FROM THE RACE DIRECTOR

- Temperature should be better for the start than it was during the rest of the week.
- Our intention is to compact from T9-T10, to keep the line as grouped as possible.
- Lights out between position 4/5 of the Formula One grid.
- The target is to do a single Formation Lap, but don't be surprised if we are doing additional formation lap(s).
- For LMGTE, a gap is accepted but please lets keep it as small as possible.
- Remind to all the working people to wear the mask at any moment.
- If a car is out of the track and the driver exists the car, we kindly ask drivers to keep the balaclava and the helmet as COVID protection.
- If you have any issue in the pit entry road, please stop on the right hand side so that the other could still access the pit lane.

QUESTIONS

Giedo Van der Garde: About the exit of T9, will it be changed?

EF: in the future we will have gravel beds there.

<u>Roman Rusinov</u>: for the SZ Lines, it will be good to have a line on the track.

<u>EF</u>: I don't like to paint lines on the circuit because of motorcycles and not to damage the surface of the circuit.

EF: what about the bump after the apex of T9?

<u>Giedo Van der Garde</u>: for LMP2 it is very disturbing.

EF: you will have to compensate it.

<u>Mike Conway</u>: inside T5, T8, the LMGTE are going so wide that they bring dirt on the track.

EF: How is the new kerb at T2?

Kevin Estre: it doesn't change anything.

<u>Sebastien Buemi</u>: a LMP2 with new tires will probably lap us. We need them to be careful and respect blue flags.

<u>EF</u>: I said during the briefing that it was up to the team managers to inform their drivers about being blue flags. We know that we have a bug we are working on it.
