The Stewards, having received a report from the Competitor Iron Dames, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below but decided to not impose a penalty due to the specific circumstances .

Fact: Modification of the crew
Offence: Alleged Breach of Art. 13.3.1 of WEC Sporting Regulations
Decision: NO penalty fine

Reason:

The Stewards were informed by the Competitor, represented by Francesca Valdani, Team Manager at Iron Dames, that the originally announced driver Sarah Bovy was tested positive to Covid 19 before heading to Spa. The second driver, Michelle Gatting, will not race either due to being in close proximity to Sarah over the last few days. The two drivers will be replaced by Doriane Pin (Silver) and Christina Nielsen (Bronze). The Stewards appreciate the effort of the team to run the car replacing the two drivers and taking into account the current pandemic decide NOT to impose a penalty considering this a case of force majeure.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 16.1.6 of 2022 WEC Sporting Regulations, Article 15.1.5 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 and 10.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
