The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Fact: Causing a collision
Offence: Appendix L, chap. IV, art. 2d of International Sporting Code
Decision: Stop and Go 1 minute

Reason:

The Stewards reviewed positioning data, in-car and cctv evidence. The driver of car 93 received blue flags prior to the incident. It appeared that he then pulled to the left at MP24 to give car 61 room to pass. Car 61 hit car 93 with a large speed differential having failed to avoid car 93 which had given sufficient room . The Stewards find car 61 fully responsible for the collision

Time penalties can only be served after they have been announced by the Race Director. Once the Stop & Go /Drive Through has been notified on the monitors, the car cannot cross the Line more than four times, except if provided under these Regulations.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Art. 16.2.6 of 2022 LeMans 24H Supplementary Regulations this decision is not subject to appeal.
