PURPOSE OF THE REQUEST

Corvette Racing requests the committee to consider the unique situation for a scheduled track test at Sebring International Raceway on Feb 16-17 in relation to sporting regulation art.8.2.4.

- The objective of this test is to finalize tire specifications for a tire option which will not be run at the Sebring WEC event. Michelin requires this information to meet production timing
- Corvette is unable to move the test earlier due to timing of IMSA Daytona 24H event
- Availability of proper race circuits with suitable climate for winter testing in the United States outside of the WEC calendar are very limited, and therefore availability is extremely challenging
- The test date was confirmed mid-2021 for tire development well prior to confirmation of Corvette WEC participation and release of 2022 WEC calendar.
