The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director and watched the video footage, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Time (fact): 17:57
Session: Race
Fact: Causing a collision with car 56 at T16
Offence: Appendix L, chap. IV, art. 2d of International Sporting Code and 9.1.11 of WEC
Decision: Stop & Go of 10 seconds
Withdraw of 2 Penalty Points

Reason:

Car 51 attempted an outside pass on car 54 at the exit of T15. Contact occurred through no fault of car 54. Car 51 spun off course, continued towards T17, and came back into the course, colliding with car 56.

Time penalties can only be served after they have been announced by the Race Director.

Once the Stop & Go /Drive Through has been notified on the monitors, the car cannot cross the Line more than four times, except if provided under these Regulations.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Art. 16.2.6 of 2023 WEC Sporting Regulations this decision is not subject to appeal.
