The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, summoned and heard from both drivers concerned and the Team Manager, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Driver: Diego ALESSI
Time (fact): 17:45
Session: FP2
Fact: Causing a collision with car 54 at T4
Offence: Appendix L, chap. IV, art. 2d of International Sporting Code
Decision: Stop & Go of 30 seconds during the Race at Spa or the next WEC of 2023 season the driver will participate & withdraw of 2 Penalty Points

Reason:

Car 54 was exiting the pits with new tyres protected by white flags (as per Driver Briefings Notes) when car 21 approached the corner of T4 and hits car 54 which stated on the racing line following clearly the instructions given by the Race Director during his briefing.

Time penalties can only be served after they have been announced by the Race Director.

Once the Stop & Go /Drive Through has been notified on the monitors, the car cannot cross the Line more than four times, except if provided under these Regulations.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Art. 16.2.6 of 2023 WEC Sporting Regulations this decision is not subject to appeal.
