



TEAM MANAGERS BRIEFING NOTES

PIT LANE PROCEDURES

- 1) Team managers to ensure the drivers ID are correct.
- 2) Any person working over the 2.5m line must be in full safety gear as per the regulations.
- 3) Access to the working lane and the fast lane will be allowed by Race Control before the start of <u>each session</u> (including Free Practices, warm up and pit lane open).

RACE CONTROL

- 4) Access by the Module Sportif 1st floor.
- 5) Discord and Pit Wall Radio to be turned on 10 minutes before the start of each session.
- 6) Other officials may send you messages on Discord; please confirm when the message is read.
- 7) Marshalling display in the car must be operational in case of failure, Race Control must be informed.

GENERAL SAFETY AND INCIDENT PROCEDURES

- 8) If during a Red Flag, Safety Car, Slow Zone(s) or Full Course Yellow procedures, if your car encounters a problem: you must instruct your driver to leave the racing line immediately.
- 9) In case of accident
 - Do not stay on the radio: this can lead to unnecessarily deploying medical services or may result in a Red Flag.
 - If the car cannot continue:
 - The driver must leave the car as soon as possible.
 - The driver must help with the recovery operations.
 - Car must be left in neutral with steering wheel in position.
 - If the car can continue: the driver must stay in the car so that the marshal can hoist the car to a safe place.
 - If the "medical light" is activated, the driver must be examined by the medical services without delay.
- 10) When going through a gravel / run off area:
 - Zig-Zag / weave your car off track before rejoining to drop the gravel / dirt off the line.
- 11) If the car is stopped for technical reasons, the scrutineers will release the car when they are satisfied with the repairs.
- 12) In Hypercar category, it is up to each competitor to ensure that the car is electrically safe at all times. The car must either have the ERS operating light illuminated (green light) or have a distinctive sign (green hat) visible to all. This sign cannot be removed until the ERS lights is green.

ON TRACK DRIVING STANDARDS

- 13) Respect across all categories.
- 14) Blue flags (Appendix H ISC Article 2.5.5.e)) are to be respected at any time.
- 15) Discord may be used between competitors to anticipate blue flags.
- 16) Track limits must be respected at all times.
 - Track limits will be monitored and listed on timing page 6.
 - Track limits are counted by driver by session. The race is considered as one session.
 - During all sessions, track limit infringements will lead to at least the deletion of the relevant lap time.
 - During sessions:
 - 4th offence in the session: warning flag.
 - 5th offence in the session: report to the Stewards.
 - During the race:
 - 11th offence in the race: warning flag
 - 12th offence in the race: report to the Stewards.







YELLOW AND DOUBLE YELLOW FLAGS - Appendix H of the ISC Article 2.5.5.b

- 17) Yellow flag(s) mean danger.
- 18) Reduce speed.
- 19) Forbidden to overtake.
- 20) Double Yellow Flags also mean that marshals and/or vehicles may be exposed, drivers must be ready to stop.
- 21) Should there be a yellow or double yellow flag at MP 25, it will always be pre-signalled at MP 24.

RED FLAG - 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations Article 14.2

- 22) During Free Practices, Qualifying sessions and Warm Up, when the Red Flag is deployed: all cars to 80 km/h and to come back in pit lane.
- 23) The Race Director may release the cars from the 80 km/h speed limit once passed the incident(s) to bring all the cars in the pit lane quicker.
- 24) During the Race, the Red Flag Line will be a virtual Line in front of the MICHELIN totem.

FULL COURSE YELLOW - 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations Article 14.5

- 25) Once FCY is deployed:
 - Yellow flags will be waved around the track and FCY board will be presented in the marshal posts.
 - Marshal post(s) of the intervention will be under double yellow flags.
 - FCY will be displayed on the onboard marshalling system.
 - All cars to slow down to 80 km/h overtaking is forbidden.
- 26) Pit entry will close when the Race Director announces "FCY will be deployed at..."
 - → During Free Practices, Qualifying sessions and Warm up, cars will be allowed to pit under FCY even if the pit entry closed light is turned on.

SLOW ZONES – 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations Article 14.9

- 27) The circuit is divided into 9 zones.
- 28) NEXT SLOW will be displayed in the MP preceding a zone. Single Yellow flags will be waved, overtaking is strictly forbidden.
- 29) SLOW will be displayed at the MP where the zone starts, double yellow flags will be waved. The car must be at 80 km/h at the MP where the Zone starts.
- 30) GREEN will be displayed on digital panels around the track (not on the onboard marshalling display) at the MP following the slow zone.

SAFETY CAR – 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations Article 14.6 – 14.7

- 31) The SC procedures will be in accordance with Art. 2.10 from Appendix H of the International Sporting Code and Article 14.6 or Article 14.7 of the 24 Hours Le Mans supplementary regulations.
 - a. SC A will enter/exit at MP 35
 - b. SC B will enter/exit at MP 27
 - c. SC C will enter/exit at MP 13
- 32) When entering the pit lane to perform a pit stop, it is the Team Manager responsibility to release its car under the correct Safety Car.
- 33) From when "Prepare for Pass Around" is announced, weaving is not allowed. Cars eligible to Pass Around will move to the RHS of the track; all other cars will remain in a single file behind the SC.
- 34) Once Race Control announces "START THE PASS AROUND" cars on the right will safely start overtaking the line of cars that are behind the SC on the left
- 35) Once RC informs that Pass Around has been concluded, cars in line behind the SC may resume weaving to help with tire temperatures.
- 36) In order to avoid the likelihood of accidents before the SC returns to its position, from the moment the lights on the car are extinguished, drivers must proceed at a pace which involves no erratic acceleration, braking, or any other manoeuvre which is likely to endanger other drivers or impede the restart.







- 37) At the end of the SC procedure, once the green flags are waved, overtaking is only allowed after each competition car has crossed the "Control Line".
- 38) At the end of the SC procedure, pit exit will only go green after the last car in line behind SC A has passed SC Line
- 39) If at any given moment the SC has to bring the field by the pit lane, it will be informed via the timing monitors. In this case all cars must follow the SC by the pit lane. At pit exit the SC will pass on the RHS of the RFID, as well as all cars following the SC.

MISCELLANEOUS

- 41) Please acquaint yourself with the Appendix C of the International Sporting Code.
- 42) International Sporting Code and appendixes must be respected during Competitions.
- 43) When placing tensor barriers in front of your garages during the other race activities, please bear in mind that the other races also need space to work, and it is not reasonable to force them to work in the fast lane.

PIT LANE PROCEDURES

- 1) Maximum speed in pit lane: 60 km/h.
- 2) Pit lane speed must be respected from pit in loop (60 km/h marker board) to pit out loop (60 km/h marker board).
- 3) Red / green at pit exit must be respected at all times.
- 4) If the red lights are on at pit exit: any car waiting at pit exit must stop before the RFID or 3 meters before the pit exit line.
- 5) Cars can be stopped by scrutineering at any time; drivers must respect the signal of the scrutineers.
- 6) Any car driving unnecessarily slow in the fast lane will be reported to the Stewards.

GENERAL SAFETY AND INCIDENT PROCEDURES

- 7) Judges of fact will be appointed to control sporting details from the Regulations.
- 8) On-board marshalling system will be used.
- 9) At all times on track, whether it is a flag or a light panel, the more restrictive will prevail, irrelevant of its source.
- 10) In case of accident
 - Signal to the marshals that you are OK as soon as possible ('thumbs up').
 - Do not stay on radio to your team: this can lead to unnecessarily deploying medical services or may result in a Red Flag.
 - If you cannot continue:
 - Leave the car as soon and as safely as possible.
 - Help with the recovery operations.
 - Car must be left in neutral with steering wheel in position.
 - If you can continue stay in the car so that the marshal can hoist you to a safe place.
- 11) During a Red Flag, Safety Car, Slow Zone(s) or Full Course Yellow procedures, if you encounter a problem: you must leave the racing line immediately.
- 12) When going through a gravel / run off area:
 - Zig-Zag / weave your car off track before rejoining to drop the gravel / dirt off the line.
- 13) In case of recovery from the gravel at MP 20, you will be placed on the asphalt at the roundabout, and you should go around the roundabout (Anti clockwise direction) to shake out the gravel before re-joining.
- 14) Any driver exiting MP32 that must use the runoff area once the car has crossed the blue line on drivers RHS with the 4 wheels then that driver must remain to the right of the blue line and must re-join the track on RHS at MP33.







ON TRACK DRIVING STANDARDS

- 15) Respect across all categories.
- 16) Blue flags (Appendix H ISC Article 2.5.5.e)) are to be respected at any time.
- 17) Discord may be used between competitors to anticipate blue flags.
- 18) It is up to the faster car to find a way to overtake in traffic: slower cars must stick to the racing line.
- 19) Track limits must be respected at all times.
 - Track limits will be monitored and listed on timing page 6.
 - Track limits are counted by driver by session. The race is considered as one session.
 - During all sessions, track limit infringements will lead to at least the deletion of the relevant lap time.
 - During sessions:
 - 4th offence in the session: warning flag.
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- 23) Double Yellow Flags also mean that marshals and/or vehicles may be exposed, drivers must be ready to stop.
- 24) Should there be a yellow or double yellow flag at MP 25, it will always be pre-signalled at MP 24.

RED FLAG - 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations Article 14.2

- 25) During Free Practices, Qualifying sessions and Warm Up, when Red Flag is deployed: all cars to 80 km/h and to come back in pit lane.
- 26) If deemed appropriate, the Race Director may release the cars from the 80 km/h speed limit once passed the incident to bring all the cars in the pit lane quicker.

FULL COURSE YELLOW – 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations Article 14.5

- 27) Once FCY is deployed:
 - FCY will be displayed on the onboard marshalling system.
 - All cars to slow down to 80 km/h overtaking is forbidden.
 - Yellow flags will be waved around the track and FCY board will be presented from the marshal posts.
 - Marshal post(s) preceding the intervention(s) will be showing double yellow flags.

Pit entry will close when the Race Director announces "FCY will be deployed at..."

→ In Free Practices, Qualifying sessions and Warm Up, you will be allowed to pit under FCY even if the pit entry closed light is turned on.

SLOW ZONES - 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations Article 14.9

- 28) The circuit is divided into 9 zones.
- 29) "NEXT SLOW" will be displayed in the MP preceding a zone. Single Yellow flags will be waved, overtaking is strictly forbidden.
- 30) "SLOW" will be displayed at the MP where the zone starts, double yellow flags will be waved. The car must be at 80 km/h at the MP where the Zone starts.
- 31) GREEN will be displayed on digital panels around the track (not on the onboard marshalling display) at the MP following the slow zone.







SAFETY CAR - 24 Hours of Le Mans Supplementary Regulations Article 14.6 - 14.7

- 32) The SC procedures will be in accordance with Art. 2.10 from Appendix H of the International Sporting Code and Article 14.6 or Article 14.7 of the 24 Hours Le Mans supplementary regulations.
 - a. SC A will enter/exit at MP 35
 - b. SC B will enter/exit at MP 27
 - c. SC C will enter/exit at MP 13
- 33) When entering the pit lane to perform a pit stop, it is the Team Manager responsibility to release its car behind the correct Safety Car.
- 34) Stalling in the fast lane and blocking other cars, because the team has released the car from the stopping area too early will be reported to the stewards.
- 35) From when "Prepare for Pass Around" is announced, weaving is not allowed. Cars eligible to Pass Around will move to the RHS of the track; all other cars will remain in a single file behind the SC.
- 36) Cars eligible for the pass around will line up on the right-hand side, and may only start overtaking the line behind the SC once RC announces "START THE PASS AROUND".
- 37) Once RC informs that Pass Around has been concluded, cars in line behind the SC may resume weaving to help with tire temperatures.
- 38) In order to avoid the likelihood of accidents before the SC returns to its position, from the moment the lights on the car are extinguished, drivers must proceed at a pace which involves no erratic acceleration, braking, or any other manoeuvre which is likely to endanger other drivers or impede the restart.
- 39) At the end of the SC procedure, once the green flags are waved, overtaking is only allowed after each competition car has crossed the "Control Line".
- 40) At the end of the SC procedure, pit exit will only go green after the last car in line behind SC A has crossed SC Line 2.
- 41) If at any given moment the SC has to bring the field by the pit lane, it will be informed via the timing monitors. In this case all cars must follow the SC by the pit lane. At pit exit the SC will pass on the RHS of the RFID, as well as all cars following the SC.






At the end of the cool down lap, the overall leader and a selected number of cars will cross the Line a second time to enter thepit lane from pit exit in the opposite direction. These cars must bear totally left at MP1 and MP2 in order to enter the pits by the pit exit and in order to go to the scrutineering. The selected car numbers will be posted on the timing monitors.

Excepting the above, at the end of the cool down lap, the overall leaders of LMP2 & LMGT3 classes will enter the pit lane by pit entry and drive their cars to park under the podium.
