The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having summoned and heard from the team representatives and both drivers of cars involved in a contact, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter

**Fact:** Contact between cars 95 and 54 at t7.

Offence: Appendix L Chap. IV, art 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code

**Decision:** Reprimand

## Reason:

Car 54 went slightly off track on the exit of Turn 6 and rejoined ahead of Car 95. Due to the speed differential, Car 95 moved to the inside line approaching Turn 7 in an attempt to overtake Car 54. This manoeuvre resulted in contact between the two cars at the apex of Turn 7.

Taking into account that the incident occurred during a Free Practice session, the Stewards determined that Car 95 could have taken avoiding action and was predominantly at fault for the collision. Accordingly, the Stewards issue a **Reprimand** to Driver Darren Leung.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 7.4.6 of the 2025 FIA WEC Sporting Regulations, this decision is not subject to appeal.
