The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having summoned and heard both drivers and team managers, have considered the following matter

**Fact:** Alleged contact between cars 35 and 36 at t12.

**Decision:** No further action

**Reason:**

During the hearing, the Stewards, together with the Team Representative and both Drivers, reviewed circuit CCTV footage and on-board video from both cars. Car 35 attempted to overtake Car 36 while approaching T12. While Car 35 was partially alongside, Car 36 moved towards the apex, resulting in contact between the two vehicles. Both Drivers agreed that the incident was due to a misunderstanding, and the Team Representative acknowledged that the team could have communicated more effectively regarding the cars' relative positions on track. The Stewards concluded that the collision resulted from a mutual misunderstanding. Considering both Drivers shared some responsibility, the Stewards determined that no further action was necessary.


