The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegates, having summoned and heard the Team representative, have considered the following matter :

**N° / Competitor:** 87 / AKKODIS ASP TEAM  
**Session:** Before the start of FP1  
**Time (fact):** On 8th May at 09:59  
**Fact:** Modifying the driver declaration without the approval of the Technical Delegates.  
**Offence:** WEC Committee Decision D013  
**Decision:** Fine of € 500

**Reason:**

Technical Scrutineering was held on Wednesday 7th May from 08:30 until 19:30. The Technical Delegate informed the Stewards that the team of car 87 amended the driver weight twice during the morning of 8th May without seeking the approval of the Technical Delegates. This is contrary to Committee Decision No. 13. The Team Representative acknowledged and apologised for the mistake.

The Stewards determined that the Competitor was responsible for this breach of the administrative procedure set out in the Committee Decision. The Stewards imposed a fine of €500 and further required the Competitor to obtain the written approval of the Technical Delegates for the weight changes.


Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
