The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**Offence:** Appendix L, chap. IV, art. 2c of International Sporting Code

**Decision:** Black and white flag

**Reason:**

After reviewing the video, the Stewards noted that Car 36, while responding to the end of the Full Course Yellow period, took partially to the grass to overtake Car 7. Car 7 then partially left the track in an attempt to regain the position. The Stewards determined that neither driver needed to leave the track in these circumstances and therefore requested the Race Director to show the Black and White flag to both drivers for driving standards.


