The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence and heard the team manager, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**Reason:**

After reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards considered that Car 15 entered the pit lane during the safety car procedure and then stopped in front of the scrutineers garage. After few seconds, Car 15 rejoined the fast lane and went to its working area to perform a pit stop.

The Stewards heard the team representative, reviewed video footage and radio communications between the team members which clearly show that the manoeuvre was intended to allow Car 20, which entered the pitlane after car 15, to perform its pit stop without having Car 15 in its working area in front of it.

In the opinion of the Stewards, to perform a pit stop, a competitor must stop only in its working area, where the mechanics and the team are located.

Furthermore, the Stewards noted that the manoeuvre was carried out without the approval or even the knowledge of race control.

Under these circumstances, the Stewards determined that the team of Car 15 receive a Reprimand.


