The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined the video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**N° / Driver:** 35 / Charles MILESI  
**Competitor:** ALPINE ENDURANCE TEAM  
**Session:** FP1  
**Time (fact):** 15:55  
**Fact:** Car 35 crossed the white line at pit entry  
**Offence:** App. L, IV, 4d of International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** Fine of 2500 euros

**Reason:**

During the hearing, the driver explained that he identified a technical issue just after passing the pit entry road. The team instructed him to enter the pit lane immediately to avoid further damage, rather than completing an additional lap. As a result, the car entered the pit lane in an incorrect manner.

The Stewards considered that the incident was entirely the responsibility of the team. However, the explanation provided does not mitigate the offence. Therefore, given the circumstances and the fact that the incident occurred during a free practice session, the Stewards decided to penalise the team with the above-mentioned fine.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
