The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter

**Fact:** Allegedly Safety Car procedure infringement.  
**Offence:** Alleged breach of Bulletin n.2 - Article 14.6.4 of 24 Hours Le Mans Supplementary Regulations  
**Decision:** No further action.

**Reason:**

The Stewards received a report regarding a safety car procedure infringement involving Car 21. The team manager attended the hearing and acknowledged awareness of the infringement. As a corrective measure, the team instructed the driver to pit immediately (no work was carried out as verified by the Stewards), where the car was held until the safety car passed, allowing the driver to rejoin at the rear of the queue behind Safety Car B. As a result, the Stewards determined a decision of No Further Action is necessary.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
