The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**N° / Competitor:** 29 / TDS RACING  
**Session:** Race  
**Time (fact):** 13:26  
**Fact:** Unsafe release in the pit lane  
**Offence:** Articles 12.1.2 of of 24 Hours Le Mans Supplementary Regulations  
**Decision:** 5 seconds added to the next pit stop.

**Reason:**

After reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that Car 29 was already in the fast lane when Car 16 was released from its working area and joined the fast lane. As a result, Car 16 had to slow down before reaching its own working area. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards deemed the incident to constitute an unsafe release and have decided to impose a 5-second time penalty on Car 29, to be served at its next pit stop.

According to Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and the article 7.4.4 of 24 Hours Le Mans Supplementary Regulations, this decision is not subject to appeal.
