APPENDIX H – Article 2.5

Yellow flag signal

- YF signals mean danger, drivers must reduce the speed & be in full control of their vehicles. Overtaking is forbidden until you pass the green flag signal.
- When double YF are shown, drivers must reduce speed and be prepared to change direction or stop. Double YF may also mean that marshals are exposed.
- It is the onus of each driver to prove that he/she slowed down. YF must be respected until the car physically passes the Green Flag.

Blue flag signal

- *Blue Flags*, if a driver has more than 2 consecutive sectors with the indication of blue flag in the marshalling display, that driver may be reported to the stewards.

Driving standards

- Respect between all drivers and categories.
- It is up to the fastest car to find a way to overtake in a safe way.

Track limits

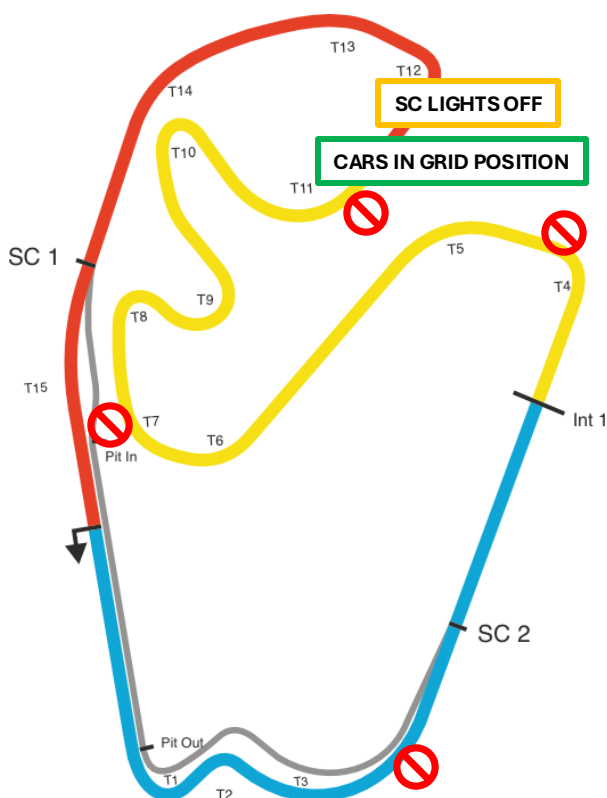
- *Cameras at T3, T4, T7 and T11.*
- Judges of fact have been appointed for other turns.
- *RHS of the right-hand kink at pit entry (near the tyre wall) will not be monitored.*

Full Course Yellow & Virtual Safety Car

- At the start of the procedure, there will be a 3 seconds tolerance after the zero countdown for cars to drop to 80km/h.

Pit lane

- Red/Green light at pit exit must be respected.
- Pit entry road white line must be respected on RHS.
- Pit exit road white line must be respected on RHS.
