The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter

Fact: Alleged contact between cars 10 and 31 at t4.
Offence: Alleged breach of Appendix L Chap. IV, art 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code
Decision: No further action

Reason:

After reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that Car 10 lost control of the car unintentionally, resulting in minor contact with Car 31. However, only Car 10 spun, and Car 31 did not suffer any significant consequences. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that no further action was necessary.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
