The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter

Competitor: PEUGEOT TOTALENERGIES

Fact: Contact between cars 94 and 21 at t11.

Offence: Appendix L Chap. IV, art 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: Warning flag

Reason:

After reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that Car 94 overtook Car 21, which had gone off track. As Car 21 rejoined the track, Car 94 moved to the right to return to the racing line, resulting in slight contact with Car 21. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that the manoeuvre by Car 94 did not meet the required standard of driving and therefore decided to issue a black and white warning flag to Car 94.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 7.4.6 of the 2025 FIA WEC Sporting Regulations, this decision is not subject to appeal.
