## APPENDIX H – Article 2.5

### Yellow flag signal

- YF signals mean danger, drivers must reduce the speed & be in full control of their vehicles. Overtaking is forbidden until you pass the green flag signal.
- When double YF are shown, drivers must reduce speed and be prepared to change direction or stop. Double YF may also mean that marshals are exposed.
- It is the onus of each driver to prove that he/she slowed down. YF must be respected until the car physically passes the Green Flag.

### Blue flag signal

- *Blue Flags, if a driver has more than 2 consecutive sectors with the indication of blue flag in the marshalling display, that driver may be reported to the stewards.*

**Red flag access gate:** Gate 3 in front of garages 7/8

**Pole position:** LHS

**Pit entry closed repeaters:** in front of box 8 – 18 – 27

**Parc Fermé after the race:** run off area in T20

**Top-4 Meeting:** Saturday 18:30– Briefing room

- *Cameras at T7, T9, T12, T15, T19, T20.*

### Full Course Yellow & Virtual Safety Car


- At the start of the procedure, there will be a 3 seconds tolerance after the zero countdown for cars to drop to 80km/h.

### Pit lane

- Red/Green light at pit exit must be respected.
- Pit entry road white line must be respected on RHS.
- Pit exit road white line must be respected on RHS.
















The neutralization signal, with the more restrictive measure, takes precedence over others





# FIA World Endurance Championship

**To:** **all Entrants in the Championship**

*Due to the forecasted temperatures for the weekend the following will apply:*

*Pit lane penalties:*

- Any car that during a session or the race gets a Pit Lane penalty that causes the car to be immobilized for 30 seconds or more, once the car is stopped in its stopping position for the purpose of serving the penalty, the driver's side door may be opened, and the cockpit may be artificially ventilated.*
- This may only be done at a distance and such equipment may not be within the vertical perimeter of the car.*

*Race:*

- During Red Flag Procedure(s) the mechanic with the Red armband will only be controlled concerning the "dress code" as long as he/she is in contact with the car (this includes holding any kind of device that interacts directly with the car).*
- If the mechanic stays away from the car(s) then the use of the dress code will not be mandatory.*
