

APPENDIX H – Article 2.5

Yellow flag signal

- YF signals mean danger, drivers must reduce the speed
 be in full control of their vehicles. Overtaking is forbidden until you pass the green flag signal.
- When double YF are shown, drivers must reduce speed and be prepared to change direction or stop. Double YF may also mean that marshals are exposed.
- It is the onus of each driver to prove that he/she slowed down. YF must be respected until the car physically passes the Green Flag.

Blue flag signal

• Blue Flags, if a driver has more than 2 consecutive sectors with the indication of blue flag in the marshalling display, that driver may be reported to the stewards.

Full Course Yellow & Virtual Safety Car


 At the start of the procedure, there will be a 3 seconds tolerance after the zero countdown for cars to drop to 80km/h.








CIRCUIT MAP










SAFETY CAR LINE 1 – PIT ENTRY ROAD








LANES IN THE PIT LANE
















PIT EXIT ROAD – SC LINE 2








