## Decision no. 2

The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence and heard the team manager, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Fact: Alleged unsafe release in the pitlane

Offence: Alleged breach of Article 12.2.2 e) of WEC Sporting Regulations

**Decision:** No further action

## Reason:

After reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that Car 99 was released from its working area at the same time as Car 31. Car 99, in the blending lane, was side by side with Car 31 in the fast lane. Then Car 31 decided to give way to Car 99.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards concluded that no breach of the regulations had occurred and therefore decided to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
