Reason:

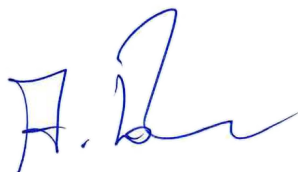
The driver of car 83 was reported speeding in the pitlane (69.62kph). As the incident took place during the period when the pit lane was open before the race, the Stewards determined that the driver was undertaking reconnaissance laps and exceeded the pit lane speed limit of 60kph in breach of article 11.2.2 of the WEC Sporting Regulations.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.

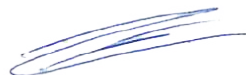
