The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter

Reason:

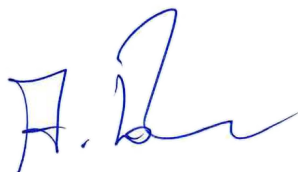
Having reviewed the video evidence, the Stewards determined that, during lap 1, approaching Turn 7, Car 36 was ahead of Car 99. While negotiating the corner, Car 99 had a small portion of its car on the inside and made contact with Car 36. As a result, Car 99 spun, while Car 36 was able to continue without suffering any significant time loss.

After considering the circumstances extensively, the Stewards concluded that it was a racing incident and therefore determined that no further action was necessary.

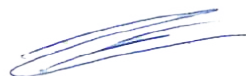
