The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Fact: Unsafe release in the pit lane

Offence: Article 12.1.2 of FIA WEC Sporting Regulations

Decision: 10 seconds added to the next pit stop.

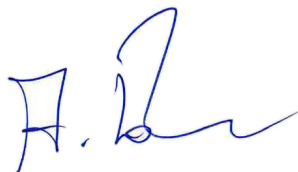
Reason:

After reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that Car 35 was in the process of entering its working area when Car 6 was released. As a result, Car 35 had to brake and steer left to avoid a collision and was also prevented from positioning itself correctly within its working area. This was deemed an unsafe release. Given the particular risk of collision and the extent of the evasive action required, the Stewards decided to impose a 10-second time penalty on Car 6, to be served at its next pit stop.

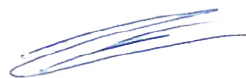
According to Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and the article 7.4.4 of WEC Sporting Regulations, this decision is not subject to appeal.
