The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having checked the video evidence, have considered the following matter

Reason:

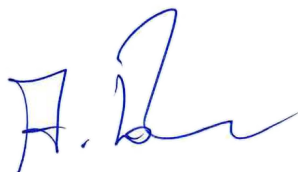
Having reviewed the video evidence, the Stewards determined that Car 33 was overtaking Car 54 on the inside at Turn 6. Car 54 moved slightly to the right and made light contact with Car 33. The Stewards consider Car 54 to be predominantly at fault for the incident and would have imposed a 5-second time penalty to be served at the next pit stop.

However, as the driver had already retired from the race when the incident was reported to the Stewards, and given that this is the final round of the season, no further action was taken.

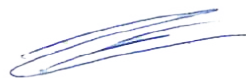
