PURPOSE OF THE REQUEST

Art. 6.5.4 Allocation

We kindly ask for clarifications about Hyperpole tyres, when SESSION is declared WET.

- 1) The wording of the 4th paragraph “*Tyres allocated for Hyperpole must be used only and exclusively for the Hyperpole session.*” refers only to dry-weather tyres or also to wet-weather tyres?
- 2) Is it authorized to use more than one set of tyres? i.e.: one set of wet- weather plus one of dry-weather; two sets of wet-weather tyres?
- 3) If dry-weather tyres are used in a WET Hyperpole, shall they be of the specification declared in Appendix 1 prior to the Competition?

COMMENTS (TO BE COMPLETED BY THE COMMITTEE)

Article 6.5.4 of the Sporting Regulations (clarified version in the WEC Committee Decision) defines the allocation of dry-weather tyres for the Competition.

Therefore, answers to your questions are the following:

- 1) Tyres allocated for Hyperpole in the allocation table only refers to dry-weather tyres.
- 2) If Hyperpole is declared WET, it is allowed to use wet-weather tyres. There is no allocation defined for wet-weather tyres. However, using wet-weather tyres is not mandatory under wet track conditions. Dry-weather tyres must be used in accordance with article 6.5.4 of the Sporting Regulations.
- 3) Dry-weather tyre specification for Hyperpole is defined in Appendix 1 of each Competition.
