1) The Stewards approved the Version V2 of the Timetable.

2) The panel of Stewards notify all Competitors and all Officials of the following **corrections to Appendix 1:**

8. Precise location at the circuit of:

3) The Stewards notify the competitors of the **addition of the following articles to Appendix 1:**

- **FOR PENALTIES NOTIFIED AND NOT SERVED BEFORE THE END OF THE RACE : ARTICLE 7.4.10 FIA WEC**

Time added for a Drive Through penalty not served: 32 seconds

Time added for a Stop & Go penalty not served: 37 seconds + the stationary time of the penalty.

(Eg : a 10 second Stop & Go penalty is converted into 37 seconds + 10 seconds, i.e a total of 47 seconds)

Derogation from the Stewards for tyre manufacturer (Art. 6.5.6 WEC Sporting Regulations)

Upon the request of tyre manufacturer Michelin of 6th May 2026 regarding the WEC Committee's Decision (WEC_2026_D10_ALL_Sporting_Clarifications_Amended 04/05/2026 Art. 6.5.6),

the Stewards grant a derogation for the tyre manufacturer concerned to recut the wet-weather tyre specification.

This modification is exclusively for the race **competition** of WEC 6 Hours of Spa-Francorchamps 2026 for the HYPERCAR category, under the condition it will supply all the competitors the same number of tyres with the same modification at the same time.
