The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having checked video evidence determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

N° / Competitor: 78 / AKKODIS ASP TEAM

Session: Free Practice 2

Time (fact): 16:49

Fact: Car 78 had a wheel fall off the car at turn 17 having left the pits at the start of the lap.

Offence: Breach of Article 12.1.1 of FIA WEC Sporting Regulations

Decision:

Fine of 5,000 Euro of which 2,500 Euro is payable now and 2,500 Euro is suspended until the end of the season.

The suspended penalty will be imposed if a similar incident occurs again and will be in addition to the penalty for the incident itself.

Reason:

The Stewards summoned and heard from the Competitors' representative and the driver (Van Rompuy). All present viewed circuit cctv footage. The Competitor informed the Stewards that the team had conducted a pit stop practice before releasing the car and that the wheel nut must not have been fully or properly fitted. The Competitor apologised for the mistake. The Stewards determined that the Competitor was responsible for the unsafe release and imposed the above stated penalty.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
