The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director and having considered the matter, determined the following:

N° / Driver: 19 / Mathieu JAMINET
Competitor: GENESIS MAGMA RACING
Session: Qualifying - Hypercar
Time (fact): 15:16:57
Fact: Cars 17 and 19 were released by the team into the Fast Lane. Car 19 had been shown a release signal but did not move for 3 seconds.
Offence: Alleged breach of Article 12.1.1 of FIA WEC Sporting Regulations
Decision: No further action.

Reason:

The Stewards reviewed the cctv evidence and determined that whilst car 19 had not immediately moved forward upon receiving the release signal, this was not a breach of the regulations in respect of being an unsafe release. The Stewards take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
