The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director and having considered the matter, determined the following:

**N° / Driver:** 7 / Kamui KOBAYASHI

**Competitor:** TOYOTA RACING

**Session:** Qualifying - Hypercar

**Time (fact):** 15:17:04

**Fact:** Cars 17 and 19 were released by the team into the Fast Lane. As the cars moved forward, car 7 was released by its team. Car 7 went into the fast lane between cars 17 and 19.

**Offence:** Alleged breach of Article 12.1.1 of FIA WEC Sporting Regulations

**Decision:** No further action.

**Reason:**

The Stewards reviewed the cctv evidence and determined that whilst cars 17 and 19 moved forward and car 7 was also released, car 19 slowed to allow car 7 into the fast lane. The Stewards, having reviewed cctv evidence determine that this was not a breach of the regulations in respect of being an unsafe release. The Stewards take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
