The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

N° / Driver: 12 / Louis Delétraz

Competitor: CADILLAC HERTZ TEAM JOTA

Session: Race

Time (fact): 15:58:26

Fact: Car 12 was side-by-side with car 35 at turn 4.

Offence: Alleged Breach of Appendix L, chap. IV, art. 2c) of International Sporting Code

Decision: No further action.

Reason:

The Stewards reviewed cctv footage which showed both cars racing side-by-side through turns 3 and 4. Whilst an initial impression was that car 12 had left the track, a close examination of the video indicated that car 12 still had part of the car on the white line and was therefore not off the track.

The Stewards therefore determine that no further action is necessary.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
