The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

**N° / Driver:** 12 / Louis Delétraz

**Competitor:** CADILLAC HERTZ TEAM JOTA

**Session:** Race

**Time (fact):** 16:38:41

**Fact:** Car 12 left the track at turn 5 and rejoined at turn 6.

**Offence:** Alleged Breach of Appendix L, chap. IV, art. 2c) of International Sporting Code

**Decision:** No further action.

**Reason:**

The Stewards reviewed cctv footage. The Stewards note that car 12 left the track and upon rejoining had initially gained an advantage, however as the car progressed through turn 6, the gap reduced and no lasting advantage was gained. The Stewards therefore determine that no further action is necessary.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
