The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having checked video evidence, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Competitor: GENESIS MAGMA RACING
Session: Race
Time (fact): 18:18:29
Fact: Car 19 was slow moving through turn 1.
Offence: Alleged Breach of Appendix L Chap. IV, art 2d) of International Sporting Code
Decision: No further action.

Reason:

The Stewards reviewed CCTV video. Noting that car 19 moved off line (to the right) approaching turn 1 and then left the turn slower than other cars, the Stewards determine that car 19 did not block or impede any of the following cars and therefore take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
