The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined video and data evidence, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**N° / Driver:** 21 / Alessio ROVERA

**Competitor:** VISTA AF CORSE

**Session:** Race

**Time (fact):** 19:37:00

**Fact:** The gap between cars 10 and 21 varied approaching the restart at the end of the Safety Car period.

**Offence:** Alleged breach of Art. 14.6.1 of the WEC Sporting Regulations

**Decision:** No further action

**Reason:**

The Stewards reviewed the cctv footage and data. Whilst the gap between the cars varied, the Stewards considered this to be a consequence of the restart after the Safety Car and the respective actions of the cars as they progressed through the braking zones, turns and acceleration zones, all of which would vary the gaps between the cars. The Stewards determine that no further action is necessary.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
