The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having checked video evidence, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**Session:** Race  
**Time (fact):** 18:58:35  
**Fact:** Cars 12 and 83 made contact at turn 18.  
**Offence:** Alleged Breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV Art. 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code

**Decision:** No further action.

**Reason:**

The Stewards reviewed CCTV video. Approaching car 18, cars 12 and 83 proceeded side by side and continued through turn 18 into turn 19. Whilst there was minor contact between the two cars, the Stewards determined that this was a consequence of the close racing and the nature of the turns. The Stewards considered that no further action was necessary.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
