The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having checked video evidence, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

N° / Driver: 51 / James CALADO
Competitor: FERRARI AF CORSE
Session: Race
Time (fact): 17:21:41
Fact: Cars 15 and 51 made contact at turn 5.
Offence: Alleged Breach of Appendix L, Chapter IV Art. 2d) of FIA International Sporting Code
Decision: No further action.

Reason:

The Stewards summoned the Competitor's Representatives and Drivers. The Competitor's Representative and Driver from car 51 attended, whilst the Competitor's Representative from car 15 attended later. The Stewards noted that both cars were side by side entering turn 5. Car 51 was on the right side and kept to the white before mounting the kerb. At the same time, car 15 was on the left side and sought to drive around the outside of car 51. Car 51 made a slight movement off the kerb whilst at the same time, car 15 moved to the right as a consequence of gravel on the track. Following contact, both cars left the track and ultimately continued. The Stewards determined that both drivers had a degree of responsibility, together with the track conditions. The Stewards determined that no further action was appropriate.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
