The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director and having considered the matter, determined the following:

Competitor: FERRARI AF CORSE
Session: Race
Time (fact): 15:38:24
Fact: Car 51 rejoined at turn 6 after having left the track at turn 5.
Offence: Alleged breach of App. L Ch. IV Art. 2c) of the ISC.
Decision: No further action.

Reason:

Car 51 left the track as a result of the earlier incident involving car 15. The Stewards reviewed the cctv footage and determined that car 51 rejoined the track in a reasonable manner, given the nature of the turn and the visibility that the driver would have had. The Stewards determined that no further action was necessary.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
