The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having examined video evidence and having considered the matter, determined the following:

N° / Driver: 51 / Antonio GIOVINAZZI
Competitor: FERRARI AF CORSE
Session: Race
Time (fact): 15:38:16
Fact: Car 51 left the track at turn 5 and rejoined.
Offence: Alleged breach of App. L Ch. IV Art. 2c) of the ISC.
Decision: No further action.

Reason:

The Stewards noted that both cars were side by side entering turn 5 but that car 51 fell in line behind car 15 proceeding through turn 5. Car 15 proceeded through turn 5 and was ahead entering turn 6. Car 51 sought to get back alongside car 15 but left the track, entering the gravel and then rejoining at turn 6. The Stewards considered that car 51 should have maintained position and not sought to overtake. The Stewards determined that no further action was appropriate.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
