The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having checked video evidence determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Decision: No further action

Reason:

After having reviewed the video evidence and the available data, the Stewards determined that the driver lost control of the car, cut the chicane, left the track and rejoined it in a safe manner.

Having considered the circumstances of the incident, the Stewards determined that no breach of the regulations had occurred. The Stewards therefore take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
