The Stewards, having received a report from the Timekeepers, have considered the following matter :

Fact: Not modifying the transponder declaration
Offence: Article 6.3.1 of FIA WEC Sporting Regulations

Decision: Fine of € 2000

Reason:

After examining the report from the Timekeeper, the Stewards noted that Cars 50, 51, 99 went on the track with a different transponder than the one declared, and that no declaration of such change had been submitted prior to the start of the FP1.

In accordance with the applicable Sporting Regulations and due to the absence of the required declaration, the Stewards hereby impose a fine of €2,000 on Cars 50, 51 and 99.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
