The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Decision: No further action

Reason:

After reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that the driver of Car 7 exited the pit lane and approached Turn 2 behind another car. The driver locked the front left tyre under braking and was consequently unable to make the corner.

The Stewards considered that the tyre lock-up may have caused damage to the tyre, resulting in a disadvantage to car 7.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that no sporting advantage was gained and therefore decide to take no further action.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
