The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, having checked video evidence determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Fact: Forcing another driver of the track at MP35

Offence: Alleged breach of Appendix L, IV 2b) of FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: 1 minute Stop and Go

Reason:

After reviewing the video evidence, the Stewards determined that, approaching MP35, Car 4 attempted to overtake Car 24 at the end of the straight. In order to avoid a collision, Car 24 was forced to leave the track. The Stewards considered the overtaking manoeuvre by Car 4 to be overly optimistic. Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that Car 4 forced Car 24 off the track and therefore failed to meet the required driving standards.

The Stewards therefore decided to impose a 1-minute Stop and Go penalty on Car 4.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Art. 7.4.3 of 2025 WEC Sporting Regulations, this decision is not subject to appeal.
