The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

Fact: Unsafe release in the pit lane
Offence: Article 12.1.1 of 24 Hours Le Mans Supplementary Regulations
Decision: Fine of 2500 €

Reason:

Having reviewed the video evidence, the Stewards determined that Car 7 was released from its working area with a tool still attached to the car. The driver returned to the pit lane on the following lap.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards concluded that, notwithstanding the fact that the car returned to the pits on the next lap to remove the tool, the incident constituted a serious safety infringement. The Stewards therefore decided to impose a fine of €2,500 on the Competitor.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
