The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Race Director, determined a breach of the regulations has been committed by the competitor named below and impose the penalty referred to.

**Fact:** Pit Stop Infringement

**Offence:** Article 12.1.1 of 24 Hours Le Mans Supplementary Regulations

**Decision:** Fine of 1000 €

**Reason:**

Having reviewed the video evidence, the Stewards determined that a mechanic dropped a bolt, which rolled onto the fast lane before being retrieved by the mechanic.

Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards concluded that the pit stop operation was not carried out in a safe manner and therefore decided to impose a fine of €1,000 on the Competitor.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
