The Stewards, having received a report from the Timekeepers, have considered the following matter :

N° / Competitor: 009 / ASTON MARTIN THOR TEAM
Session: Before Hyperpole 1 Hypercar
Time (fact): 21:08
Fact: Transponder change declaration after the regulatory deadline.
Offence: Article 6.3.1 of 24 Hours Le Mans Supplementary Regulations
Decision: Fine of € 500

Reason:

After examining the report from the Timekeeper, the Stewards noted that Car 009 declared a transponder change after the deadline specified in the Sporting Regulations. The deadline for declaring a transponder change was 20:50, being 15 minutes before the start of Hyperpole 1 for the Hypercar category, but the declaration was only communicated by the Team at 21:08.

In accordance with the applicable Sporting Regulations, and due to the failure to make the required declaration within the prescribed time limit, the Stewards decided to impose a fine of €500 on the Competitor of Car 009.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 5 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
